SEMINAR STRUCTURE & CONTENT

The Seminar, chaired by ESPI Director H. Ludwig Moeller, seeks to explore the role of space in shaping all four of EFA's 2024 thematic priorities: Climate, Finance & Economy, Security, and Democracy. Each daily seminar session will develop the link between space and one relevant domain. Sinead O'Sullivan will explore the link between space and the economy, Gen. Michel Friedling will dive into the role that space plays for security and Volker Liebig will spark the conversation on the potential of space to address the climate crisis. Another module will be devoted to how space fosters the sense of European cohesion.

FORMAT & SPACE POLICY CHALLENGE

The Seminar will use a **highly interactive format**, with group division, fishbowl sessions, group conversations, fireside chats, and pitch competitions. Throughout the Seminar week, participants will **work on a space policy challenge, devoted to exploring innovative solutions to untap the full potential of space in other policy domains. The last day of the seminar will be devoted to presenting the participants' findings through a discussion with the co-chairs and a pitch competition.**
