4th ESPI VSD Newsletter



It is with great pleasure that I share with you the 4th edition of the VSD newsletter. As we near the midpoint of 2024, we have successfully hosted a number of events for our VSD community. This period of intense activity included our first Inter-Regional Dialogue between Europe and the Latin America and Caribbean region. Additionally, ESPI organised a VSD's side event on the outcome of the World Radiocommunication Conference 2023 (WRC-23), focusing on its implications for the space domain. Through these events, we continue to promote a "strong Europe, as a partner to the world."

1st Inter Regional Dialogues with GRULAC

On April 20th, ESPI organised the first Inter Regional Space Policy Dialogue between Europe and Latin America and the Caribbean in partnership with the Permanent Mission of Argentina and CONAE. Government and space agency representatives from 18 countries and international organisations gathered together to discuss space for sustainability. The dialogue highlighted the need for collaboration and cooperation, while continuing to emphasise the important role diplomats, as main policy actors, play in space policy debates. The second edition of the dialogue is scheduled for April 2025 in partnership with the Permanent Mission of Brazil and the Brazilian Space Agency (AEB).

WRC-23's Outcomes

On April 16th, ESPI hosted a successful VSD side event facilitating an open exchange on the outcome of the World Radiotelecommunication Conference 2023 (WRC-23). This discussion took place as a side event to the 63rd United Nations Committee on the Peaceful Uses of Outer Space.

The event highlighted the implications of WRC-23 for the space domain, addressing several issues shaping the future of spectrum management across terrestrial, maritime, and space services. Along with fellow researchers from our institute and guest panellists, our event fostered a discussion on the potential impacts of the concerns raised by WRC-23 on the space sector.







NEXT VSD ENGAGEMENTS

We are thrilled to announce two further events just before the summer break. We warmly welcome all VSD members to join us, for a side event co-organised with Chile and Spain along with VSD's Inter-Regional Dialogue.

COPUOS's 67th session

On June 20th, ESPI, Spain and Chile, as co-chair of APEP-Space through the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, will put forward a panel discussion on the challenges and potential solutions to preserve "Dark and Quiet Skies", for astronomical observation while allowing other endeavours, such as the deployment of satellites in Low Earth Orbit (LEO). Through this, we aim to raise awareness on how to foster responsible behaviour and solutions that reconcile science with business development. In response to the growing interest and support for this topic, this panel will foster constructive dialogue among government representatives, the private sector, and the scientific community.

4th Interregional Dialogue with Asia-Pacific

After three successful interregional dialogues between Europe and the Asian Pacific region, ESPI will co-host its 4th edition on the **22nd of June** 2024. With JAXA as the Secretariat of the Asia-Pacific Regional Space Agency Forum (APRSAF), the interregional session will provide a platform for dialogue and exchange between European countries and Asia-Pacific. This coming session will explore **new funding pathways for the Global Space Economy** through expert technical presentations and roundtable discussions, featuring government and space agency officials from both regions. The event is open to all COPUOS delegates with mandatory registration at this <u>link</u>.

VSD Summer Reception

As previously announced in our newsletter, the 2nd VSD Summer Reception is just a few days away.
